

**Stafford County Commissioners**  
Minutes of Meeting  
January 18th, 2023

\*\*\*\*DRAFT MINUTES\*\*\*\*

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, January 18th, 2023, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Garner called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Todd Wycoff, Bryce Garner, and Jim Stanford.

Patrick Jacobs, GBT, discussed the proposals submitted to rewire the network. Currently all departments are all on one big network and any virus or attack could spread to other departments and affect everyone. He would like to separate everyone out into their own network to isolate and minimize any attack threat. Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to approve the GBT network upgrade proposal in the amount of \$24,651.20. Motion carried 3-0.

Kurt Fairchild met with the commissioners to discuss HB No. 2002 which Representative Bret Fairchild will be introducing next week in Topeka. This bill would allow for the taxpayer notification costs fund to reimburse county clerks for the printing and postage costs associated with the RNR mailing beyond calendar year 2023. The current bill only allows for reimbursement to county clerks through the 2023 year. Kurt discussed with them that personal testimony from a county representative would be most beneficial. Commissioner Garner will present testimony in support of the bill by Zoom on Tuesday morning.

Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to approve the minutes of the January 11th session. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to accept the tax roll corrections. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Garner recessed the meeting at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Garner reconvened the meeting at 9:11 a.m.

Brian Dunn, Brad Lickiss, Remington Smith, and Cody Dick, Stafford County Extension Board, met with the commissioners to give an update on how the extension district consolidation has been going.
