Minutes of Meeting
February 8th, 2023

****DRAFT MINUTES****

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, February 8th, 2023, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Commissioner Garner called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Bryce Garner, Todd Wycoff, and Jim Stanford.

Marissa Hurst and Maribel Tovar with the Stafford County Office of 21 Central Extension District and Brian Dunn, Board Member were present to discuss the current situation with the extension district. Discussion was held regarding what the benefits of the extension district are as well as what the needs of the Stafford County area are.

Phillip Nusser, Road & Bridge, presented information to the commissioners regarding a new oil burning furnace. The current furnace is old enough that it is becoming unreliable and the manufacturer is out of business making parts difficult to obtain. There was discussion regarding the possibility of a natural gas furnace system. Phillip will also get information for a gas furnace system. Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to approve Phillip to use his discretion to purchase a new furnace system for the county shop. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to approve the minutes from the February 1st session. Motion carried 3-0.

Carl Miller, County Appraiser, came in to discuss the 2023 Market Study Analysis and new Ag Use Values. He went over the report and explained it. He also advised that new valuations are ready to be mailed out to taxpayers.

Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded to approve the tax roll corrections. Motion carried 3-0.
