

Stafford County Commissioners
Minutes of Meeting
February 25, 2026

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met on Wednesday, February 25, 2026, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Garner called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Bryce Garner, Todd Wycoff, and Jim Stanford.

Misty Rudy, EMS Director, met with the commissioners to update them on the status of her department. She has a current volunteer EMT that will be transitioning to a full-time employee. She also advised that she has four employees that have finished training to upgrade their certification level. Misty also presented bids for body vacuum splints and extremity vacuum splints to replace the rigid spine boards & extremity splints that are currently used. Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to approve the purchase of two vacuum spine boards and two super deluxe extremity vacuum splint sets from Danko for a total of \$5,145.00. The purchase will be paid from the EMS Reserve Fund. Motion carried 3-0.

Trent Harman, Road & Bridge Supervisor, presented a contract for geological testing on behalf of KDOT for the new bridge project. Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to approve the agreement for Professional Engineering Consultants, P.A. (PEC) to complete the core drilling for bridge project No. 260162-000. Motion carried 3-0. Trent also advised that the road grant application with Pawnee County has been completed and submitted.

Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to approve the minutes of the February 18th meeting. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to approve the tax roll corrections. Motion carried 3-0.

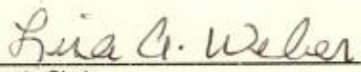

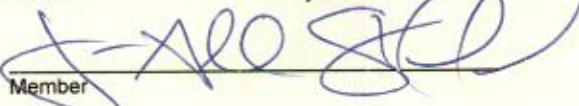
