

Stafford County Commissioners
Minutes of Meeting
March 4, 2026

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met on Wednesday, March 4, 2026, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Garner called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Bryce Garner, Todd Wycoff, and Jim Stanford.

Shannon Snyder, Health Dept Director, presented the annual provider agreement for the Health Department and Dr. Farmer. Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to sign the provider agreement. Motion carried 3-0. Shannon also advised that she has finished all of the grant paperwork for the next cycle and presented the signature page for the Chairman to sign. She gave an overview of how those different funds are dispersed and how they are used. Shannon let the commissioners know that the health department will be holding the community baby shower again this year on May 6th. She also updated them on the current activity in her department.

Brooke Haulmark, CKCC, presented the KDOC 2027 funding allocation document. She discussed the responsibilities of Central Kansas Community Corrections and how funding is utilized. Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to approve CKCC to accept the Kansas Department of Corrections Funding for Fiscal Year 2027 for the total amount of \$808,438.94.

Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to approve the minutes of the February 25th meeting. Motion carried 3-0.


Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Wycoff seconded, to appoint Keith Rose as Byron Township Clerk to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Virgil Salem. The appointment is effective March 4, 2026.


Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to accept the Community Development Block Grant for the Macksville Child Care Facility. Motion carried 3-0.


