

Stafford County Commissioners
Minutes of Meeting
March 11, 2026

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met on Wednesday, March 11, 2026, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Garner called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Bryce Garner, Todd Wycoff, and Jim Stanford.

Jewell Glover, 21 Central Extension, met with the Commissioners to invite them to participate in a Barbeque Cook-off for the County Fair. The cook-off will be open to 4H members. The Commissioners agreed to be judges and will pool together prize money for the winner. Once the final schedule for the County Fair is set, she will rejoin the Commission to present.

Marshal Sanders, Fire Director, joined to clarify the Fire Department's role in Solar Regulations and the responsibilities that will impact the department. He asked about the potential for supplemental fire suppression. The need for additional buildings and trucks was discussed. He also discussed the Grain Rescue Equipment he's gotten and the potential need for enclosed trailers to house and move the supplies and an upcoming training day for the equipment.




Commissioner Wycoff motioned to approve the minutes of the March 4, 2026, meeting. Commissioner Stanford seconded. Motion carried 3-0.
