

**Stafford County Commissioners
Minutes of Meeting
March 24th, 2021**

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, March 24th, 2021 in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Grimmatt called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Clayton Grimmatt, Todd Wycoff and Bryce Garner.

Phillip Nusser, Road supervisor, presented a utility permit application from Northern Natural Gas Company for maintenance on a pipeline in the northern part of Stafford County, along the north side of NE 170th Street between the SW/4 of 22 and NW/4 of 27, both in 21-13. Commissioner Wycoff moved and Garner seconded to approve permit application 2021-003. Motion carried 3-0. An Authority to Award Contract for Project No. 093 C-4979-01 to Century Fence Company, Pewaukee, Wisconsin, on a signing and pavement marking project was presented. The amount of the contract is \$ 261,755.00. The expense will be reimbursed back to the county by a grant. Commissioner Garner moved and Wycoff seconded to accept the contract for \$ 261,755.00 for road striping. Motion carried 3-0.

Shannon Snyder, Health Director, along with Emergency Preparedness Director Phillip Nusser, discussed resolution 2021-14 to lift the mask order for the county. Commissioner Wycoff moved and Garner seconded to approve resolution 2021-14. Motion carried 3-0. Although Stafford County will not require the wearing of a mask or face covering while in a public space located in the county, KDHE still recommends that masks or face coverings be worn in public. This resolution DOES NOT prohibit a business or organization in the county from requiring its employees, customers, visitors, invitees or members to wear a mask or face covering while in or at such business or organization, while on its premises or property, or while at any event or activity of such business or organization. All persons should be respectful and compliant of each individual business or entity's mask restrictions.

Commissioner Garner moved and Wycoff seconded to approve the minutes from the March 17th session. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Garner moved and Wycoff seconded to approve the tax roll correction. Motion carried 3-0.

Sheriff Rob Murrow, presented employee evaluations for the sheriff department. A salary increase request for David Eulenstein was discussed. Commissioner Garner moved and Wycoff seconded to increase Eulenstein from range 8 step 4 to range 8 step 5, effective March 1, 2021. Motion carried 3-0.
