


Ryan Witt, Noxious Weed Director, presented the 2025 Noxious Weed Eradication Report to the commissioners for review. Discussion was held regarding the statistics in the report. Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Wycoff seconded, to accept and sign the 2025 Noxious Weed Eradication Report for submission to the State. Motion carried 3-0. Ryan also submitted the 2026 Noxious Weed Management Plan. Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to accept and sign the 2026 Management Plan. Motion carried 3-0. Ryan also gave an update on the spraying activity in his department to date.


Oleg Alba with AcreStrong met with the commissioners to discuss renewable energy county negotiations. He explained various aspects of what should be considered when the county negotiates a PILOT (Payment in Lieu of Taxes) for any type of project such as solar energy.


