**Minutes of Meeting  
April 9, 2025**

**DRAFT MINUTES**

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met on Wednesday, April 9, 2025, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Stanford called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Jim Stanford, Bryce Garner, and Todd Wycoff.

Upon the request of Cheryl Budge, Appraiser, Commissioner Garner moved to recess to executive session for 5 minutes pursuant to the attorney-client privilege KOMA exception to discuss a legal question regarding a program policy. Motion carried 3-0. Those present: Commissioners, County Appraiser, County Clerk, County Attorney. Into executive session at 8:35 a.m. Open session resumed at 8:40 a.m. in the commission chamber. Chairman Stanford stated that the record reflect action shall be taken consistent with the consensus reached in executive session. Motion carried 3-0.

Misty Rudy, EMS Director, joined the meeting to discuss HB2280. This bill would allow counties under 30,000 in population to have one person trained as an EMT or Paramedic in an ambulance, with the ambulance driver only being required to have CPR training. This would allow smaller communities to have more staffing flexibility. Misty explained that if the bill passes Stafford County would most likely utilize this procedure just for routine transfers. These drivers would be subject to background checks and defensive driving training.

Commissioner Garner advised that Valeta Ward will no longer be mowing the Prairie Chapel Cemetery for the county. A replacement will be found as soon as possible

Vanessa Cornwell, Treasurer, presented the 2025 Quarter One Investment Report. Interest on county investments was \$35,437.81 for the first quarter of the year.

Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Wycoff seconded, to approve signing the agreement with Kimble Mapping, Inc. for GIS Map Maintenance for 2025. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Wycoff seconded, to approve the minutes from the April 2<sup>nd</sup> session. Motion carried 3-0.

Lisa Weber, County Clerk, presented Resolution 2025-8 revising the pay schedule for election workers. Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Wycoff seconded to approve Resolution 2025-8. Motion carried 3-0.
