

Stafford County Commissioners
Minutes of Meeting
May 18th, 2022

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, May 18th, 2022, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Wycoff called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Todd Wycoff, Bryce Garner and Clayton Grimmatt. Others present: Lisa Milton.

Patty Fensky and Kevin Alpers with the Stafford County Conservation District presented their 2023 budget request. Their request remains the same as last year at \$25,000.00. Discussion was held regarding the assistance the county has provided with ARPA funds for new septic systems in the county. Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Grimmatt seconded, to allocate \$20,000 from ARPA funding to do a cost share for five new septic systems in 2022. Motion passed 3-0.

Angie Hanson joined the meeting to discuss the revised plan for updating the landscaping around the courthouse and annex buildings. She also advised that she had mowed down the growth in the cleared lot south of the courthouse and it is ready for Ryan Witt to spray.

Commissioner Wycoff recessed the meeting at 8:45 a.m. Meeting was reconvened at 8:47 a.m.

Lisa Milton joined the meeting. The commissioners discussed with Lisa the work that she is doing to assist the Treasurer's office.

Commissioner Wycoff recessed the meeting at 8:50 a.m. Meeting was reconvened at 8:54a.m.

Shannon Snyder, Health Dept Administrator, joined the meeting to discuss some issues that have been caused over social media postings regarding her department and her billing procedures. She also updated the commissioners on the progress of the new digital messaging sign that will be installed at the health department building.

Commissioner Wycoff recessed the meeting at 9:05 a.m. Meeting was reconvened at 9:11 a.m.

Ryan Witt, Noxious Weed, joined the meeting to discuss the septic system funding with the commissioners. Ryan wanted to confirm the status to determine if he could proceed with a current request and any additional requests that may come in. Ryan also advised that he is having issues with the well at his shop causing some water issues which may require a new pump. Ryan verified that he will be spraying around county buildings and the cleared lot.

Commissioner Grimmatt moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded, to proceed with a \$2500.00 quarterly allocation to Grace Walk, Inc. Motion passed 3-0.

Commissioner Grimmatt moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded, to approve the minutes from the May 11th session. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Grimmatt moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded, to approve the tax roll corrections. Motion carried 3-0.

Chairman Wycoff recessed the meeting so that the commissioners could review the annex building storage areas with the meeting to adjourn afterwards.
