Minutes of Meeting  
June 29th, 2022

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, June 29th, 2022, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Wycoff called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Todd Wycoff, Bryce Garner, and Clayton Grimmatt.

Melissa Ille and Delaney Smith, Adams Brown, CPA, presented the 2021 audit report. Melissa then went over a preliminary rough draft of the 2023 budget. Discussion was held regarding current department budget needs and the Revenue Neutral Rate process. Melissa will work on options for the commissioners based on the current information. They will then hold a budget workshop to work on making final budget decisions.

Upon the request of Sheriff Rob Murrow, commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Grimmatt seconded to recess to executive session for 5 minutes pursuant to the non-elected personnel exception to discuss non-elected personnel. Motion carried 3-0. In at 9:35 a.m. Out at 9:40 a.m. Those present: Commissioners, County Clerk, Rob Murrow.

County Attorney, Mike Robinson, invited the commissioners to attend a meeting at his office on July 11<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. to discuss a plan to better accommodate citizens with mental health issues. All three commissioners will attend this informational meeting.

Vanessa Cornwell, County Treasurer, presented a step increase for Chrissy Green. Commissioner Grimmatt moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded, to move Chrissy Green from Range 5, Step 3 - \$15.09 to Range 5, Step 4.- \$15.57 effective July 1, 2022. Motion carried 3-0.

Upon the request of Vanessa Cornwell, Commissioner Grimmatt moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded, to recess to executive session for 5 minutes pursuant to the non-elected personnel exception for 5 minutes to discuss non-elected personnel. Motion carried 3-0. In at 9:45 a.m. Out at 9:50 a.m.

Commissioner Grimmatt moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded, to approve the minutes from the June 22nd session. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Grimmatt moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded, to approve the tax roll corrections.

Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Grimmatt seconded, to recess to executive session for 5 minutes pursuant to the non-elected personnel exception to discuss non-elected personnel with no action and to adjourn after. Motion carried 3-0. In at 10:10 a.m. Out at 10:15 a.m.
