

**Stafford County Commissioners
Minutes of Meeting
September 9th, 2020, 2020**

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in the Community Room of the Annex on Wednesday, September 9th, 2020. Chairman Fairchild called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Kurt Fairchild, Clayton Grimmatt and Todd Wycoff. Bryce Garner and Brian Anshutz were present.

Shannon Snyder, Health Director, updated those present on the COVID pandemic. There are currently 10 active cases in the county as of meeting time. 7 pending tests have been done recently. A couple of positive cases showed up over the weekend, affecting a school district in the county. KDHE guidance was sought to handle the situation. The decision was made by school administration to quarantine the high school students, junior high students and staff due to the fact that contact tracing was not going to be able to be done effectively. Communication between the health department and the school administration continued on Tuesday in the hopes that contact tracing could be done to return most of the students to class. In the end, no definite plan was agreed upon. A drive through flu clinic is being planned for November.

Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to opt out of the presidential executive order to defer payroll taxes for Stafford County employees. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to approve the minutes from the September 2nd session. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to allow the county clerk to purchase a 6' x 12' Lark cargo trailer from Sunflower Trailer Sales for \$ 3,250.00 to transport election equipment to and from the polling locations. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Fairchild moved and Grimmatt seconded to recess to executive session for five minutes pursuant to the non-elected personnel exception in order to discuss a performance matter. Motion carried 3-0. In at 9:04 a.m., out at 9:09 a.m. Those present: commissioners, county attorney and county clerk.
