

**Stafford County Commissioners  
Minutes of Meeting  
September 22nd, 2021**

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, September 22nd, 2021, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Grimmatt called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Clayton Grimmatt, Todd Wycoff, Bryce Garner, Julie Lyon, and Carolyn Dunn.

Phillip Nusser, Road Dept Supervisor, advised that a traffic control evaluation has been done at the intersection of NW 200<sup>th</sup> St and NW 40<sup>th</sup> Ave. As a result, he presented Resolution No. 2021-22 designating that stop signs be installed on NW 200<sup>th</sup> St at the intersection of NW 40<sup>th</sup> Ave. Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Wycoff seconded to approve Resolution 2021-22. Motion carried 3-0. The Road Department will install the appropriate stop signs at the intersection. Phillip also informed the board that he has been advised that due to the inability to obtain the required paint that the newly sealed roads will not be striped at this time. The striping should be able to occur next spring.

Discussion was held regarding the possible need for a backup IT system if our current IT technician is unavailable and there would be an immediate need for assistance or service. Department heads will be contacted to discuss the issue and implement a plan.

Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Wycoff seconded to approve the minutes from the September 15th session. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded to allocate \$250,000 of ARPA funding to the Stafford County Fair Board for the construction of a new fair building. Motion carried 3-0.

Discussion was held regarding an AI security system that could be utilized throughout the county by law enforcement as well as local entities. The consensus was to have Rob Murrow, Sheriff, make contact with the security company and set up an informational meeting to obtain additional information regarding this system.

Chairman Grimmatt recessed the meeting at 9:10 a.m. The meeting was reconvened at 9:45 a.m.
