

**Stafford County Commissioners
Minutes of Meeting
September 23rd, 2020**

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in the Commissioner Room in the courthouse on Wednesday, September 23rd, 2020. Chairman Fairchild called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Kurt Fairchild, Clayton Grimmatt and Todd Wycoff. Bryce Garner was present.

Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to approve the minutes from the September 16th session. Motion carried 3-0.

Misty Rudy, EMS Director and Mike Robinson, County Attorney discussed a memorandum of agreement between SJN Bank of Kansas and the county for the building at Hudson that currently houses the ambulance. Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to accept the donation of the building from SJN Bank of Kansas located on Lots 9 and 10, Block 18, O.S., City of Hudson. Motion carried 3-0.

Amy Boxberger, Central Kansas Community Corrections and Marissa Woodmansee, 20th Judicial District Juvenile Services met with the board. Amy requested approval for FY 2020 year-end outcomes report for the Kansas Department of Corrections. Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to approve the submission of the report as presented to the department of corrections. Motion carried 3-0. Marissa then presented information on juvenile reform, which will play into the amount of funding that will be available.
