

**Stafford County Commissioners**  
Minutes of Meeting  
October 12th, 2022

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, October 12th, 2022, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Wycoff called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Todd Wycoff, Bryce Garner, and Clayton Grimmett.

Phillip Nusser, Road & Bridge, presented information regarding pickups. Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Grimmett seconded to authorize Phillip to purchase a 2009 Chevrolet pickup from Federal Surplus for \$14,000.00. Motion carried 3-0. He also presented information regarding a 2023 Ford F-150 XLT 4WD Super Crew Pickup. Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Grimmett seconded, to authorize the purchase of the 2023 Ford Pickup through National Auto Fleet out of the Special Machinery Fund. Phillip also advised that an additional office employee has been hired effective October 24<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioner Grimmett moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded, to accept the minutes from the October 5th session. Motion carried 3-0.

Robert Murrow, Sheriff, presented a step increase for Natalie Hogie. Commissioner Grimmett moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded, to increase Natalie Hogie from Range 4, Step 1, to Range 4, Step 2 effective October 1<sup>st</sup>.

At the request of the commissioners, Marshal Sanders, Robert Murrow, and Misty Rudy came in to discuss implementing a protocol to offer emergency services employees debriefing and mental health assistance.

Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Grimmett seconded, to recess to executive session for 20 minutes pursuant to the non-elected personnel exception to discuss a personnel matter. Vanessa Cornwell, Treasurer, joined the meeting to introduce new treasurer department employee Kandis Nemec to the commissioners.
