

**Stafford County Commissioners
Minutes of Meeting
October 21st, 2020**

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in the Commissioner Room in the Courthouse on Wednesday, October 21st, 2020. Chairman Fairchild called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Kurt Fairchild, Clayton Grimmatt and Todd Wycoff. Bryce Garner, Commissioner Elect District # 3, and Millissa Schidecker were present.

Commissioner Fairchild moved and Grimmatt seconded to recess to executive session for 15 minutes pursuant to the attorney-client privilege exception. Motion carried 3-0. In at 8:31 a.m., out at 8:46 a.m. Those present: County Commissioners, County Attorney, County Clerk and Bryce Garner, Commissioner Elect District # 3.

At the request of Misty Rudy, EMS director, Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to recess to executive session for 15 minutes pursuant to the non-elected personnel exception in order to discuss a personnel matter. Motion carried 3-0. In at 8:50 a.m., out at 9:05 a.m. Those present: County Commissioners, County Attorney, County Clerk and Bryce Garner, Commissioner Elect District # 3.

Josh Meyer USD 350 Superintendent, Blain White, USD 350 Jr/Sr high school principal, and Carl Behr, USD 350 School Board member, met with the board regarding the close contact/quarantine order revision. The verbiage defining a close contact: A person is considered a close contact of a case if they were within 6 feet of the case for 10 minutes or more or if they had exposure to secretions (for example, being coughed or sneezed on). If the individual is properly wearing a face covering, then he or she will be identified as a close contact if they were within 3 feet of the case for 90 minutes or more. This mask exception may be eliminated or become more restrictive as circumstances require. Close contacts must remain in quarantine until they have met the criteria for release from quarantine set by KDHE or the local health department. As long as the school board has approved the modification the commissioners have no objection but will not take a formal position on the verbiage.

Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to approve the minutes from the October 14th session. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to have the chairman sign a letter of support for Sunflower Diversified services for the annual KDOT grant. Motion carried 3-0.
