Minutes of Meeting
November 9th, 2022

****DRAFT MINUTES****

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, November 9th, 2022, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Wycoff called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Todd Wycoff, Bryce Garner, and Clayton Grimmatt.

Mike Minton, Gallagher Benefits, presented the annual Utilization Summary Report for 2022. He went over that information as well as preliminary information for the 2023 health insurance renewal. Discussion was held regarding renewal options &/or changes for the 2023 year. Mike will return with final renewal information for the commissioners to decide on in the next two weeks.

Vanessa Cornwell & Lisa Milton, Treasurer's Office, joined the meeting to discuss the employee pay scale with the commissioners. They also went over the eligibility for properties going to tax sale and discussed the procedure going forward.

Phillip Nusser, Road & Bridge, came in to discuss the county's permit fee for house movers. The fee has been at \$1.00 for several years and Phillip suggested that the fee be brought more current by raising it to \$250.00 to cover any sign, etc. damage that could possibly occur. Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Grimmatt seconded to increase the house moving permit fee to \$250.00. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Grimmatt moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded, to accept the minutes from the November 2nd session. Motion carried 3-0.
