Minutes of Meeting
November 16th, 2022

****DRAFT MINUTES****

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met as a Board of Canvass on Wednesday, November 16th, 2022, Chairman Wycoff called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Todd Wycoff, Bryce Garner, and Clayton Grimmatt. Jim Stanford, Commissioner-Elect District #1 was also present.

Results of the November 8, 2022, General Election were reviewed. There were five provisional ballots presented for consideration. Two ballots were not counted as the voters were not registered in Stafford County. One ballot was not counted as the voter did not present a valid ID at the polling place or thereafter up until the canvass. One ballot was not counted as the voter had already returned an advance mail ballot. One provisional ballot was counted and added to the final unofficial election results.

The election results were certified by the Canvass Board.

The meeting of the Board of Canvass was adjourned at 8:30 a.m.

The meeting reconvened as the Stafford County Board of County Commissioners. Chairman Wycoff called the meeting to order at 8:40 a.m. Present: Todd Wycoff, Bryce Garner, and Clayton Grimmatt. Jim Stanford, Commissioner-Elect District #1 was also present.

Commissioner Grimmatt moved, and Commissioner Garner seconded, to accept the minutes from the November 9th session. Motion carried 3-0.

Vanessa Cornwell, Treasurer, presented information for revised monthly motor vehicle stipends as well moving treasurer department clerks to Range 6 on the pay scale. She also presented a step increase for her Deputy Treasurer. Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Grimmatt seconded, to approve a new graduated scale for the motor vehicle pay stipends as well as the step increases for treasurer department employees as follows: Lyndsey Roth from Range 5, Step 1 \$14.44 to Range 6, Step 1 \$15.51; Kandis Nemecek from Range 5, Step 1 \$14.44 to Range 6, Step 1 \$15.51; and Karen Petty from Range 8, Step 2 \$18.03 to Range 8, Step 4 \$19.05 effective 12/01/2022. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Garner moved, and Commissioner Grimmatt seconded, to pay the calendar year 2022 membership term of \$1,100.00 for Great Plains Development, Inc. Motion carried 3-0.
