

Stafford County Commissioners

**Minutes of Meeting
November 22, 2023**

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, November 22, 2023, in the Commission Room in the Annex. Chairman Garner called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Todd Wycoff, and Jim Stanford.

Marshal Sanders, Rural Fire Director, came in to discuss information on a new compressor/fill station. They have been having numerous issues and costly repairs with the unit in St. John. He presented a bid from Weis Fire & Safety. Commissioner Stanford moved, and Commissioner Wycoff seconded, to approve the bid of \$37,973.00 from Weis for the new compressor/fill station. Motion carried 2-0. Marshal also advised that he will be purchasing an emergency plug for electric cars. This disables the vehicle should it be involved in an accident, preventing it from operating or moving while the scene is being worked. Marshall also advised that eight tires are needed for the tender truck. He can obtain tires at a reduced price rather than purchasing them through another dealer. Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to allow Marshall to purchase the eight new rear tires for the tender truck. Motion carried 2-0. He is also looking for another truck like this one with the goal of having a tanker truck for each station.

Commissioner Wycoff moved, and Commissioner Stanford seconded, to approve the minutes from the November 15th session. Motion carried 2-0.

Vanessa Cornwell, Treasurer, presented the 2022 tax roll to the commissioners. This shows the total taxes for 2022 and the amount collected, which is 98.36% leaving a delinquency rate of only 1.64%. She also advised them that 2023 tax statements have gone out. An updated report on interest earned was also presented.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 a.m.
