

NOTICE OF PLACES AND DATES
OF REGISTRATION

In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2310, notice is hereby given that the books for registration of voters will be open at the Stafford County Clerks office from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Residents of Stafford County can register to vote at the following locations during regular business hours:

Office of the County Clerk, 2nd Floor, Courthouse, St John, KS

Office of City Clerk, 220 N Main, Macksville, KS

Office of City Clerk, 115 E 4th, St John, KS

Office of City Clerk, 112 W Broadway, Stafford, KS

Stafford County Health Dept., 610 E 1st Ave, St John, KS

At 5:00 p.m. on the 15th day of October, 2024 the books for registration will close and will remain closed until the 6th day of November 2024.

A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age or older or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) years on or before the election, must register before he or she can vote. Registration is open until the close of business on the 21st day before the election.

When a voter has been registered according to law, the voter shall remain registered until the voter changes name by marriage, divorce or other legal proceeding or changes residence. If any of the preceding has occurred, you must re-register.

Application forms shall be provided by the county election officer or the Secretary of State upon request. For an application by mail call 620 549-3509 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday-Friday, print an application by going to www.voteks.org or www.staffordcounty.org and mail or bring the application to the Stafford County Clerks Office, 209 N Broadway, St John, KS or register online at www.voteks.org. The application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.
