

**Stafford County Commissioners  
Minutes of Meeting  
March 25th, 2020**

The Stafford County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in the Community Room of the Annex on Wednesday, March 25th, 2020. Chairman Fairchild called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Present: Kurt Fairchild, Clayton Grimmatt and Todd Wycoff. Bryce Garner was present.

Shannon Snyder, Health Director, met with the board to provide an update on the COVID 19 virus. Executive order No. 20-14 from the Governor was discussed. Snyder will be contacting restaurants in the county to ask that they move to a take-out or drive through only policy until further notice. Snyder stressed the importance of practicing good hand hygiene and to stay home unless it is absolutely necessary to get out. There are currently no positive cases in Stafford County, test results are still out on several individuals. Shannon noted that if there is a positive case in the county. KDHE will send out a press release. The Health Department has gone to an appointment only policy, while the courthouse is still closed to the public, but taking calls, emails, and helping customers that come to the door.

Carl Miller, County Appraiser, met with the board to inform them that PVD has amended the crude oil price, dropping from \$ 46.00 per barrel to \$ 23.00 per barrel for 40 and above gravity oil. Miller estimates that the assessed value for oil will drop by 1.8 million dollars, thus hurting the valuation for the county, townships and schools. A letter will be drafted and sent out by the Appraiser Office to the affected entities.

Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to approve the minutes of the March 18th session. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to appoint Chairman Fairchild to be the commission point person at any COVID 19 heath meetings. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Wycoff moved and Grimmatt seconded to recess to executive session pursuant to the attorney/client privilege exception in order to discuss a legal matter. Motion carried 3-0. In at 9:34 a.m., out at 9:44 a.m. Those present: Commissioners, County Attorney and County Clerk.
